University Highlight



If your summer travel plans include a visit to Yellowstone National Park, it might be worth brushing up on your [seismology](#). Researchers from the **University of Utah** and the University of New Mexico have concluded that the long-debated question of a potential Yellowstone volcano eruption is now moot. By generating 110 small, controlled “earthquakes” throughout the park, the team collected data using seismometers and produced high-resolution images of the subsurface. These findings offer new insights into the geological activity beneath Yellowstone.
